Smell - Making your way to Chandni Chowk, you will hop onto bicycle rickshaws and zig zag through the bustling bazaar built during the Mughal Empire, transporting you back in time, where you will be ready to indulge in a workshop that fires up your senses- the Ittar or perfume making workshop. Rumour has it that Mughal Emperor Jahangir's wife may have been one of the first patrons of the industry. Visiting an 8th generation ittar studio, you will get to smell and mix your own unique concoction you can name after yourself.



DAY 2

Touch – Making your way through the busy lanes filled with shops and food, you enter a beautiful touch of calm at the heart of Old Delhi's mayhem, the Jama Masjid, also known as the 'Friday Mosque', rests in the centre of Old Delhi. The marble and red-sandstone structure was Shah Jahan's final architectural triumph, built between 1644 and 1658. (Please dress conservatively for the mosque).

Taste – After such a busy morning it is only fit to break for the flavors which have been enticing you on your walk. Lunch on many of the dishes Old Delhi is famous for.

Sound – After Lunch you will drive through the city learning of the British history in India, making your way to the Bangla Sahib Gurudwara. Here you will hear the sounds of Gurbani at Delhi's largest Gurudwara. The magic that the Gurudwara envelopes you into is undeniable. The sweet sound of the Gurbani playing in the background is perfect for reflecting on the day's adventure.

Area Overview

The soul purpose of visiting Agra is the Taj Mahal. Built by Shah Jahan, the Taj Mahal is a white marble memorial to his beautiful wife Mumtaz Mahal. Designed and planned by the Persian architect Ustad Ahmad Lahori, the monument took 22 years to complete and is recognized as the greatest architectural achievements of the Indo-Islamic architectures. It was not only designed with balance and perfect symmetry, but its elegant domes and lace like intricate carved screens personify its beauty.



DAY 3

The Agra Fort was the main residence of the emperors during the Mughal Dynasty until 1638, when the capital was shifted from Agra to Delhi. Once in the possession of Akbar, the Emperor commissioned it to be rebuilt in red sandstone for his reign and the capital city of the Mughal Empire. The fort houses many structures, including Palaces Jahangir Mahal and Khas Mahal, a Public Hall and the Moti Masjid (Mosque) within its 2km walled perimeter. The Mughals lost the Fort in the early 17th Century when they were defeated by the Maratha Empire and the changes to the Fort were begun.

Eventually, the British destroyed many more structures within and by 1947, only a handful of the main structures were left standing when it was handed over to the Indian Government. In 1983, the Agra fort was life inscribed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Evening visit of Mehtab Bagh (Garden): Taj Mahal looks stunning from its grand entry. But Emperor Shahjahan booked the best view of Taj Mahal from a grassy, crescent-shaped flood plain across the river Yamuna that is known as Mehtab Bagh. It is believed that this garden was built originally by Babur, but later Shahjahan transformed it into a moonlit pleasure garden profuse with white plaster pathways, breezy pavilions, pools and fountains. However, plaster pathways, pools and fountains are not visible



DAY 4

Sunrise At Taj Mahal

Activity overview

Rise early (**Around 0515 am**) for morning coffee and prepare for a truly spectacular sight, the legendary Taj Mahal at daybreak. It is often said that Taj Mahal changes its colours by every minute depending upon angle of sunrays and it is best seen either by sunset or sunrise. Sunrise however is best timing for taking pictures of this monument under mild sun light.

Area Overview

Ranthambore is teeming with wildlife, and one of the most popular wildlife parks in India. This dry deciduous forest in Rajasthan was once the hunting ground for the Jaipur royals. It is home to several species and is one of the best parks to spot a tiger.

In the midst of the thorny, scrubby vegetation, interspersed by tracts of grassland, you will find some of India's oldest Banyan trees — and a wide variety of wildlife. From felines to crocodiles, waterfowl to primates, and several herbivores and reptiles, one can explore this park over and over again and still not see it all.

It's charm is elevated by ruins of its past, such as an ancient temple complex overrun by monkeys, and beautiful chattris (pagodas) and a former fortress that lie along the banks of the river. Watching a tiger prowl amid through the arches and crumbling ramparts is a sight to behold.

Ranthambore plays a pivotal role in tiger conservation & is a key reserve for Project Tiger's conservation and research efforts. This park has some of India's oldest tigers and some of its youngest. Thanks to tireless conservation efforts, the tiger population in Ranthambore has grown at a very healthy rate, and new cubs are born each season.



DAY 4

The prey-base is abundant, and herbivores like sambhar, spotted deer, Nilgai antelope, and the chinkara gazelle, often fall victim to the predators.

A large number of ponds, waterholes, and streams make Ranthambore a favourite with birds. The River Chambal snakes through the park, & one often finds animals pausing for a drink along its banks. You will often find several species of waterfowl like pelicans, ibises, storks, and cormorants, as well as chattering parakeets, bulbuls, hornbills, and darting kingfishers. Ranthambore is also a popular hunting ground for raptors and it's not unusual to spot falcons, eagles, or owls

Our guides and trackers visit the park every day and keep a track of these movements by checking the spoor of the tigers and listening to the alarm calls of animals.

During your morning safari, you will stop for a picnic breakfast and then continue on with the rest of your morning Safari, returning to the lodge for lunch and a little down time.

After Tea and Coffee load up into your jeeps with your guide and tracker. Set off for the afternoon safari, experiencing the park in a new light and noticing the change in the activeness of the jungle.

DAY 6

Area Overview

Colour me pink! Jaipur gives you a birds eye view of India through rose-tinted glasses. History, heritage, romance waft across its skyline — through the fairy-tale galleries of the Hawa Mahal (Palace of the Winds), over the ramparts of Amer Fort, and across the exquisitely manicured gardens of Rambagh Palace.

Jaipur is full of street candy — literally, as the old city's bazaars are lined with sweet shops selling toothsome burfi, and vendors dishing up sizzling yellow and orange jalebis fresh off the griddle at street corners in the Pink City. It's also a shopaholic's fantasy with lines of shops selling just about everything from jootis (shoes) to jewellery (particularly the silver and stones that Rajasthan is famous for).

Shopping in Jaipur is a mesmerising experience for the uninitiated. Before you know what's happening you'll have tie-dye saris and duppattas (scarves) draped over your shoulders, bejewelled bangles being slipped onto your wrist, a rope of pearls strung around your neck and a cup of hot tea and a sizzling jalebi pressed into your hand. How can you resist? So what's with the rosy hue? In 1876, HRH Edward Albert, Prince of Wales, decided to pay a visit. The Maharaja of Jaipur, Sawai Ram Singh, decided to give the city a glowing facelift and painted all the buildings pink. The pink has outlived both.

Jaipur is all about living to the fullest. Everything is a little larger than life here. The Jantar Mantar is a great place to start with its massive astronomical instruments scattered across an outdoor park. Amer Fort dominates the skyline. Encounters Asia leads you on a guided hike through the woodland behind the fort gives you birds eye views of the old city, and a unique perspective on the fortress itself.

There's a palace around every corner. Jaipur revolves around the City Palace, which stands majestically in the heart of the city. Ornate and opulent, the City Palace has a regal hauteur about it.

On this fascinating evening walking Tour mingle and talk with locals whilst sampling some of the regions culinary delights; try Samosa Kachori, Kulfi and Lassi. Sample sweets from some of the city's most popular Mithai Wala's. Observe local artisans like Silversmiths, Bangle makers, at work. Meet a local family and experience Indian hospitality. It's a great way to explore Jaipur like locals do and learn about rich art traditions of this fascinating city.



DAY 7

Amber Fort

Activity overview

A Morning visit to the magnificent Amber Fort, the most iconic monument of Jaipur. Your pick up from the hotel will take you to the bottom of the Aravali hills where you will load up into Jeeps for a ride to the top of the hill and begin your tour of the Amber Fort.

In shades of honey and rose stone, white marble and gilt decor, Amber Fort is more of a palace than a fortress, and the design is a unique mix of Hindu and Muslim styles. The 4 expansive sections house many palaces, halls, gardens, and temples. Including one of the most mesmerizing halls, Sheesh Mahal, with its walls covered with elaborate mirror work, it well worth the visit.

Our visit to the Fort will take approximately two hours.

Royal Grandeur Tour Of City Palace

Activity overview

Enjoy a memorable **private guided** tour to visit City palace, the residence of the present Royal family who have opened their gates to visitors and converted a part of their palace into a museum. The palace of Jaipur which is full of brilliant architecture and intricately carved walls and pillars. Visit the beautiful Chandra Mahal or Chandra Niwas which is the most commanding building in the City Palace complex.



DAY 7

It is a seven-storeyed building and each floor has been given a specific name such as the Sukh-Niwas, Ranga-Mandir, Pitam-Niwas, Chabi-Niwas, Shri-Niwas and Mukut-Mandir or MukutMahal. It contains many unique paintings, mirror work on walls and floral decorations. There is beautiful peacock gate at the entry to the Mahal. It has screened balconies and a pavilion at the roof from where a panoramic view of the city can be seen. It is set amidst well laid out gardens and a decorative lake in the foreground.

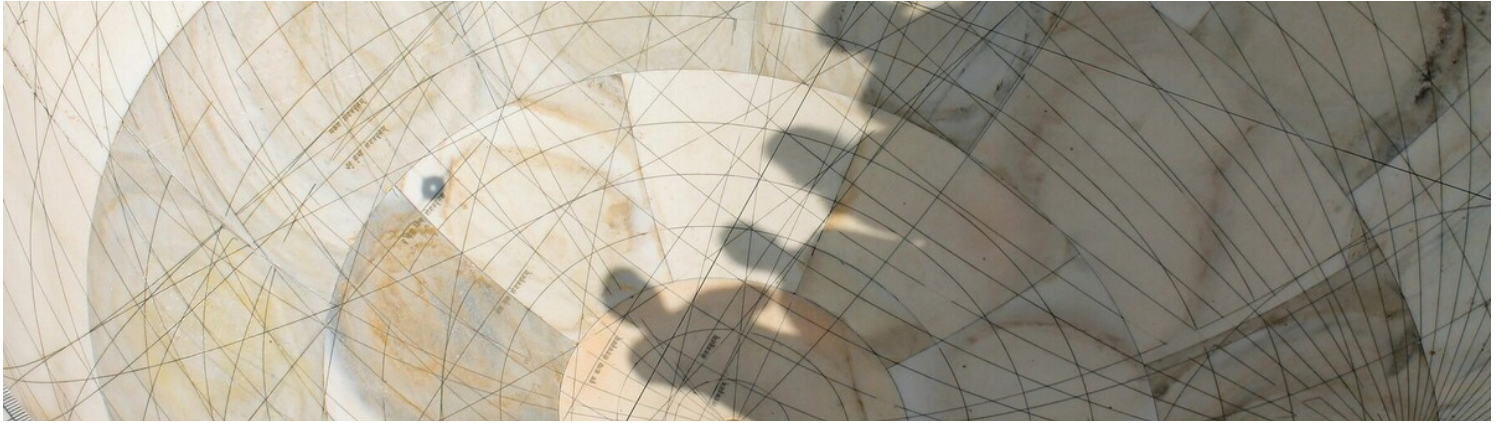
DAY 7

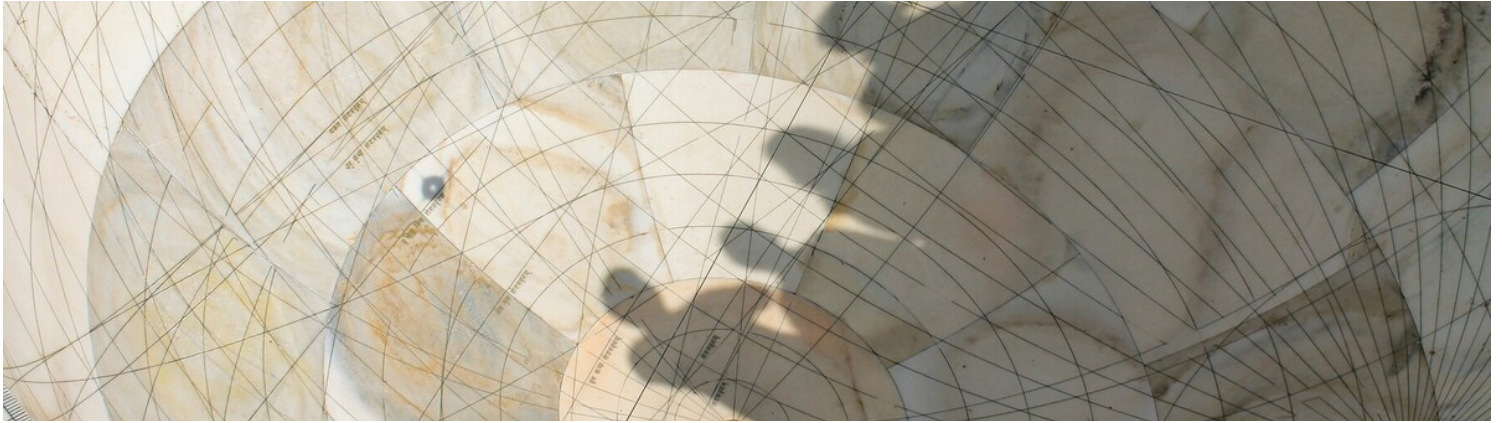
