

It is renowned for its ancient rock-cut temples and stone carvings. A UNESCO World Heritage site, it is famous for the Shore Temple, Pancha Rathas, and the intricately carved Descent of the Ganges. These stunning monuments, dating back to the 7th and 8th centuries, showcase the architectural brilliance of the Pallava dynasty. Set along the Bay of Bengal, Mahabalipuram is not only a significant cultural and historical site but also a popular destination for its scenic beaches and vibrant local art scene.

### Shore Temple And Five Rathas

# **Activity overview**

We begin our day with visiting the UNESCO World Heritage sites before traveling to Pondicherry.

The Shore Temple, located in Mahabalipuram, Tamil Nadu, is a magnificent 8th-century granite structure overlooking the Bay of Bengal. This UNESCO World Heritage site is one of the oldest stone temples in South India and is renowned for its intricate carvings and elegant Dravidian architecture. Built during the reign of the Pallava king Narasimhavarman II, the temple consists of two shrines dedicated to Lord Shiva and one to Lord Vishnu, symbolizing the fusion of Shaivism and Vaishnavism. Its unique seaside location, along with its artistic and architectural significance, makes the Shore Temple a timeless monument and a key highlight of Mahabalipuram's cultural heritage.

A short drive away, 1.5 km, we visit the Five Rathas.

The Five Rathas, also known as Pancha Rathas, are a remarkable set of monolithic rock-cut temples located in Mahabalipuram, Tamil Nadu. Dating back to the 7th century and carved during the reign of the Pallava dynasty, each ratha (chariot) is dedicated to a figure from the Mahabharata, though none were ever used for worship. These five distinct structures—Dharmaraja Ratha, Bhima Ratha, Arjuna Ratha, Nakula-Sahadeva Ratha, and Draupadi Ratha—are carved from single granite blocks and exhibit different architectural styles, representing the early stages of South Indian temple design. Surrounded by detailed sculptures of animals and deities, the Five Rathas stand as a testament to the craftsmanship of ancient Indian artisans and are a UNESCO World Heritage site.

#### Welcome to Matrimandir Auroville

#### **Area Overview**

Auroville stands for.

The Matrimandir, located in Auroville near Puducherry, India, is a spiritual and architectural marvel that serves as the central meditation space for the Auroville community. Designed by the founder of Auroville, Mirra Alfassa (The Mother), the Matrimandir symbolizes the soul of the city and represents the pursuit of inner harmony and consciousness. The structure is a large golden sphere set amidst sprawling gardens, its reflective discs shining in the sunlight.

Inside the Matrimandir, a quiet, pristine meditation chamber known as the Inner Chamber features a central crystal globe that reflects sunlight, creating a serene and focused environment for introspection. Surrounding the structure are twelve gardens, symbolizing different qualities of consciousness. The Matrimandir is not associated with any religion but is a

The unique blend of French and Indian influences is the characteristics of Pondicherry. The neighborhood is dotted with cafes, bakeries, and boutiques. A walk through the French Quarter offers a pleasant mix of history and culture, with a slower pace.

Visit of Auroville with Gopi (subject to availability)

A half hour's drive from Pondicherry is the experimental township of Auroville. This fascinating society is based on the concepts of sustainable and holistic living. Auroville is located in a forest that was planted and nurtured from barren land, by the Aurovilleans themselves. Auroville (City of Dawn) is an experimental commune made up of people from over 50 countries. It aims to be an ideal society, a place of human unity where people can live and work, irrespective of creed and nationality. Auroville is a utopian and compelling idea, where collective ownership and sustainable living are central concepts. Your guide is a local Aurovillean, who will give you an insider's view of its history, economy, decision-making processes, ecology, and technology.

Your Expert was raised in Auroville amongst both visiting and local communities. With a master's in media and history in documenting traditional livelihoods in rural Tamil Nadu and an enthusiasm for storytelling and 7 years in tourism, he has formed relations with valuable networks that inspired the concept behind sustainable tourism. Creating meaningful connections between people, places, and products is what allows Gopi to serve as a neighbourhood concierge.





DAY 3

We will begin with a **morning meditation** session at the Matrimandir (subject to permission from the previous day)

After the meditation session, we will begin sampling delicious goodies at the Auroville bakery, and then head on to the visitors Centre. Here you'll get a visual tour of Auroville through several exhibits and a short video. You'll see how the community turned hundreds of hectares of barren land into lush forests; and the various methods being developed for waste management, women's empowerment and organic farming. The Visitors Centre also has a large shopping complex for Auroville's high quality products, such as food, clothes, crafts, books and home accessories. We will visit several workshops and projects at Auroville, depending on your interests and the time available. The Wellpaper unit is a women's empowerment initiative which produces baskets, accessories and other handmade items out of old newspaper. Other units in Auroville include a wonderfully creative musical instrument workshop, an indigo dyeing workshop, a bamboo experiment centre, organic farming, food processing, just to name a few. For lunch, we will go to Auroville's Solar Kitchen, where you can see the huge solar panels and learn about how Auroville meets its energy needs. During the tour, you will be able to see the grand Matrumandir (Mother's Temple), an architectural marvel.

Entry into the Matrumandir will be based on your previous day's registration.

#### Srirangamnathaswamy Temple

#### **Activity overview**

The Sri Ranganathaswamy Temple, located in Srirangam near Tiruchirappalli, Tamil Nadu, is one of the largest and most significant temples dedicated to Lord Vishnu in India. Spread over 156 acres, it is not only the largest functioning Hindu temple in the world but also an important pilgrimage site, especially for devotees of the Vaishnavite tradition. The temple is dedicated to Ranganatha, a reclining form of Lord Vishnu, and is known for its immense religious, architectural, and cultural importance.

The temple's complex is a magnificent example of Dravidian architecture, with its towering gopurams (gateway towers), intricately carved pillars, and expansive courtyards. The tallest of these gopurams, the Rajagopuram, stands at 236 feet, making it one of the tallest in Asia. Inside the temple, there are numerous shrines, halls, and sanctuaries, including the central sanctum that houses the idol of Lord Ranganatha reclining on the serpent Adisesha.

#### **Activity overview**

# After breakfast drive to Alleppey to board the Houseboat.

Embark on the backwaters for a nigh, locally known as a Kettuvallam. The Kettuvallam, literally 'tied together boat,' is a comfortable and traditional way to get around the Backwaters. In times past this was Kerala's equivalent of a container ship, up to 100 feet long and able to carry 30 tons of cargo. Great planks of seasoned and oiled Jack wood were lashed together with coir rope and seams stuffed with coconut fibre before being slathered with a nice goop of boiled cashew shells to keep it watertight. Not a single nail used.





DAY 9

Climb aboard and there's a bamboo and palm thatched canopy to provide shelter from the sun, comfy cane chairs from which to watch the world go by and a table to take your meals at. There are one or two simple bedrooms with en-suite loo and shower though the water pressure is often so low you're better off using the bucket and jug to wash. Your houseboat is run by a crew of two or three local men who keep the engine chugging, steer it along the lagoon and arrange a canoe ride along a canal.

A cook rustles up delicious meals in the impossibly small galley and there's nothing for you to do except sit back and enjoy the view, lie in the sun or catch up on that holiday reading you promised yourself

After Dinner, spend some time gazing at the fabulous stars up above, before heading in for bed. The air-conditioning is on for an hour or two before the generator is turned off and the peace of the Backwaters returns once more.

Fringing the coast of Kerala and winding far inlands is a vast network of lagoons, lakes, rivers and canals. These backwaters represent a unique geographical formation and are basis of a distinct lifestyle.

The vibrant city of Kochi (Colonial name Cochin), situated on the south-west coast of the Indian peninsula in the breathtakingly scenic and prosperous state of Kerala, is hailed as 'God's Own Country'. Its strategic importance over the centuries is underlined by the sobriquet Queen of the Arabian Sea. Informally, Cochin is also referred to as the Gateway to Kerala. Being an important part of the spice trade, various settlers occupied Kochi leaving behind their remnants throughout the city. From Synagogues, to churches to Portuguese and Dutch architecture, to Chinese fishing nets the city holds its history with pride.

#### Kathakali Dance





**DAY 12** 

#### **Activity overview**

Kathakali is a traditional dance form of Kerala and the impressive facial expressions, hand gestures and dance moves will leave one spellbound. Kathakali Dance is characterized by elaborate makeup, colorful costumes, hand gestures and facial gestures, dancers apply make-up, made from various natural pigments which are ground on a stone and mixed with coconut oil, before performance. Traditionally, all the colors used in the make-up are obtained from natural substances and locally available herbs mixed with a base of coconut oil.

For example, the red and yellow colors are made by powdering stones like Chaayilyam and Manayola respectively. White, sued for accents and outlining is a combination of rice flour and lime. The green color is produced by mixing Manayola and Neelam (blue). Another stone, Chenchilyam is powdered and applied in order to protect the skin from burns. Kajal or kohl (the black substance) is prepared by burning gingerly oil and a new cloth. The ashes are made into the makeup. If you've ever used saffron in cooking, you know how effective this herb, used for orange, can be at staining.

# Cultural Tour Of Kochi

# **Activity overview**

After breakfast you will be introduced to the highlights of the city of Kochi.

The tour begins with a visit to the **Jewish Synagogue** (**closed on Friday & Saturday**), built in 1568 by the prosperous Jewish trading community. The oldest synagogue in India, it was partially destroyed in the war of 1662 and was rebuilt by the Dutch. In the mid-18th century the clock tower was added and the floors paved with exquisite hand-painted blue willow tiles from China - no two tiles are alike.

Continue on to the **Dutch Palace** (**closed on Friday**), originally built by the Portuguese in the middle of the 16th century. The structure was taken over in 1663 by the Dutch, who added some improvements before presenting it to the Rajas of Cochin, who made further improvements. This palace is notable for some of the best mythological murals in India.

Next stop will be **St. Francis Church**, the oldest European church in India, originally built in 1503. The Portugese explorer, Vasco da Gama, died in Kochi in 1524 on his third visit to India, and his body was originally buried in St Francis Church, before his remains were returned to Lisbon 14 years later. Close by is the Santa Cruz Basilica, considered to be one of the finest and most impressive churches in India.





**DAY 13** 

Driving back to hotel, you will also get to see the iconic **Chinese fishing nets** (Cheenavala) that are distinctly unique to this city. It is believed that traders from the court of the Chinese ruler Kublai Khan introduced these nets here. Oddly, these nets are found only in Kochi, not China! Many fishermen earn their livelihood by fishing using these massive nets, with a whole stretch of the coast alon g Fort Kochi and Vypeen dotted with them. Your tour concludes with a visit to Fort Cochin - a small community in itself.

Since it is a natural harbor and one of the most important trade centers in south of India, Kochi Fort of Kerala is one of the most important towns in the state. One can see a unique blend of Dutch and Portuguese influences in Fort Cochin, due to the rulers from these areas having occupied Cochin for many years.
